Construction Consultants recently completed a major renovation of the Cutchogue-New Suffolk Free Library. One half of the building is in a church built in 1862 that was stabilized on wood cribbing and steel in order to excavate and build a basement community room. A second story mezzanine was also built throughout the entire building; this requiring the addition of several dormers. In the end, the project approximately doubled the square footage of the building without changing the footprint.
